

KNIS 50TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION PROGRAM SCHEDULE

INTERVIEWS

The following interviews will air weekdays on His People, 12:30 PM and 9:30 PM Pacific, and 1:30 PM and 10:30 PM Mountain, except for Nov. 13.

Nov. 13—His People starts a half-hour early today, so we can bring you the complete earliest recording we have of KNIS. It's 24-year old Tom Hesse with his roving microphone interviewing people during an open house for the brand new station 50 years ago.

Nov. 16—An archived interview with the late Art Storrs, founder of Pilgrim Radio, on how God raised up this radio ministry in one of the most unlikely places in America.

Nov. 17—Early volunteer Jim Satterfield, now with the Lord, came here simply to learn about radio, but God used KNIS to transform his life. Hear Jim tell the story.

Nov. 18—Our "His People" program began airing on KNIS in 1979. We present excerpts from the first few programs, revealing topics of discussion and news of the era.

Nov. 19—Our Music Director/Volunteer Coordinator in the early 1980s was Craig Miller, now living in Tennessee. In a recent phone interview, he shares recollections of his time here and the value of Christian radio.

Nov. 20-24—A new 3-part series, featuring Cliff Denney (our first General Manager) and Tom Hesse (our second General Manager), with inspiring stories of God's provision for Pilgrim Radio through the years. They joined us in the studio recently to record this special series for our celebration.

Nov. 25—KNIS signed on the air exactly 50 years ago today. Current General Manager Tim Weidemann, Program Director Bill Feltner, and Community Relations Director Patrick Herman share their insights and recollections as we bring our anniversary celebration to a close.

Nov. 9—Tim Weidemann, Bill Feltner, and Patrick Herman discuss the various music styles played on Pilgrim Radio through the decades, and give a preview of all our anniversary programming.

Nov. 12—A 2007 interview we did with Eddie Degarmo of Degarmo & Key.

Nov. 13—A young Twila Paris is featured on this radio special from 1984.

Nov. 16—The group Harvest with music and comments from 1983.

Nov. 17—Remembering the life and music of Rich Mullins, featuring his brother David Mullins and co-writer of songs Mitch McVicker.

Nov. 18—Michael Card interview and music from 2007

Nov. 19-20--Two-part radio special on the life and music of Keith Green, produced in 1987.

Nov. 23—Wayne Watson music and interview from 2007.

Nov. 24—Amy Grant’s “Straight Ahead” radio special from 1984.

Nov. 25—The KCSP Story...how Pilgrim Radio expanded to Wyoming. In this recent interview, Tom Hesse and Tim Weidemann describe the steps God used to open doors for ministry throughout Wyoming.
